I, the undersigned, hereby apply to have one of the following words registered for use as a prefix in the names of dogs bred by me (***Stud Prefixes are limited to one word consisting of not more than twelve(12) letters***).

I am aware that -

- (1) The word allotted must be used as part of the names of all dogs bred by me and that no other word which could be regarded as a prefix may be used in their names.
- (2) No dog may be entered for exhibition, advertised or otherwise referred to by only part of the registered name, including the prefix (if any), or by a name different to the registered name.
- (3) The names of dogs (including the prefix) are limited to thirty digits (including spaces).

I/We make this application on the understanding that I/ we thereby become bound by the Constitution, Regulations and Code of Ethics of the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc for the time being in force and any decisions of the Council of the T C A Inc.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING USE OF STUD NAMES

To obviate the need of correspondence and alterations to names, the conditions governing the use of prefixes are drawn to your attention:

1. Although a receipt is issued by the TCA Inc following payment of a fee for registration of a stud name, the granting of the application is subject to:-
 - (a) Approval by the Central Register of the Australian National Kennel Council.
 - (b) Applications are submitted twice per month to the Central Register. This will occasion some delay but applicants will be advised as soon as a clearance is received on the prefix allotted.

The use of the approved word is permitted, provided –

- (1) It be used in naming every dog and bitch bred by the owner of the word.
- (2) Is not used in naming dogs the owner of the word did not breed.
- (3) No other word which could be construed as a prefix be used.

PLEASE NOTE – Clauses 1 and 2 above are applied very strictly. If, for some instance, the word be registered for a husband, it may not be used in naming dogs bred by his wife or family, and vice versa. If registered by Mr. & Mrs. Blank it may not be used in naming dogs bred separately by Mrs. Blank or by Mr. Blank or by any other person. Not infrequently, bitches are presented by owners of stud names to members of their families, the bitches duly whelp, and the puppies not being bred by the owner of the registered prefix may not carry the word in their names.

If it is desired to exhibit as a Kennel, for example "Clonaig Kennels", rather than one's own name, a form must be obtained from and lodged with the TCA Inc.

FEES: STUD PREFIX \$120.00

MEMBERS SHOULD BE AWARE OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE T C A INC PRIOR TO LODGING AN APPLICATION TO REGISTER A LITTER OF PUPPIES.

NOTE: ONLY FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF THE TASMANIAN CANINE ASSOCIATION INC MAY APPLY FOR THE REGISTRATION OF A PREFIX
