Representatives are requested to submit a report of any irregularities in the running of the show or conduct of exhibitors/stewards/judges. If an exhibitor complains to the rep about the behaviour of any other exhibitor or breach of Regulations the rep is to instruct the complainant to make such complaint through the Event Manager or in writing to the TCA Inc.

A representative is to observe only and except in cases as provided under the Regulations of the TCA Inc is not to give advice on the running of the show.

***This does not however, alleviate the representative from the responsibility of reporting any breaches of regulations that are brought to their attention.***

The Reps report *must* be in the hands of the Executive Officer of the TCA Inc. within seven (7) days of the trial
