Collie joined our family in April 2014 as a 10-week-old pup. We bought him from Glenorchy where I met his mother (a Koolie) and his father (a Kelpie). Shortly after this I joined the Eastern Shore Dog Club to ensure he was obedient and well socialised, given we live in the country with very few people around.

We enjoyed Obedience Training and by 2015 had started Rally O when our instructor suggested we try trialling. We entered our first Rally O Trial in February 2016 and never looked back.

Collie is a friendly, anxious and very cuddly dog who is always committed to doing his best in anything I ask of him. Given that he is the first dog I've had who has been involved in any form of dog performance sports, it's been a very exciting and amazing learning journey together. By the end of 2016 Collie had achieved his Advanced title in Rally O and was trialling in Masters by the end of 2017. In April 2019 we finally achieved the ten scores of 90 or better and he gained his Rally O Champion title. He earned his Novice Obedience title in 2018 and we decided to finish up Obedience to try out other things.

Agility/Jumping are now part of our performance journey and we moved into Masters Jumping this year. In this discipline I am the one holding us back as I struggle to learn the more advanced skills and remember the courses. He is most definitely the Master in our Masters partnership. In 2021 we also started in Tracking and managed to pass our first Track with a Very Good.

I am blessed to have this beautiful boy as a partner in our journey. Many thanks to Barb Duke and Wendy Job who were my early mentors in Obedience/Rally and to Louise Riley, Angie Kennerson and Peter and Veronica Hofto for their patience in supporting our Agility learning.

Responding to Activists

STEPS FOR HANDLING CONFRONTATION AT AN EXHIBITION OR EVENT

Proudly show our practices are best practice	Regardless of the risk of confrontation, every exhibitor should proudly uphold the standards expected of us as loving dog owners and members of Dogs Tasmania and present our dogs and ourselves positively.
Advise the show or trial manager, call 000 if needed	Advise the event manager if you believe activists are present and they will advise the local police. If activists create a disruption or confrontation. call 000 immediately. If you call 000 clearly articulate the risk that the activists are posing: to yourself and others, the dogs' welfare, personal and venue property, etc.
Do not engage	Do not engage directly. Keep calm even if provoked and keep your distance if possible.
Ask them to leave	If activists enter the area you are using to house your dogs, speak with them politely to ask them to leave. Acknowledge their right to state their opinions in a lawful manner but ask that they respect your right to continue to look after your dogs' welfare in a safe manner without distress. Ask them to please leave the area and move to a space away from the dogs. They may not respond to the request, but it will make it clear they do not have permission to be there. Do not engage with them further.
Move yourself and your dogs to a safer position	Your safety and welfare and that of your dogs comes first. If activists won't leave, relocate to an area that is safer for you and your dogs.
Create a record	Video footage and photos taken on your phone of the above can be used by police. If there has been damage to property record the details and if possible wait until police have examined the scene before touching anything. Please always consider the safety of yourself and dogs when confronted with activists.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Hi Everyone

As advised in my last report, our elections for Council for 2022, received only two nominations for the four vacancies. Consequently a by-election has been held for those two vacancies. Only two valid nominations were received for those vacancies, so I am pleased to congratulate Steve Eastley and Roseanne McDade on their election to Council. Steve is of course returning and we welcome Roseanne as a new Councillor.

Well the borders have been lifted and with the exception of Western Australia and there seems to be a free flow of people between the states.

During January, because of the test requirements, quite a few judges could not fulfil their appointments and clubs were struggling to find replacement judges. The Omicron strain is rampant and I hope everyone is doing everything they can to stay well. Even though travel requirements have been relaxed, it will be interesting to see if judges are reluctant to travel or indeed if sufficient locals are available to do all the necessary jobs to make a show run smoothly.

It is also interesting to note that Queensland has cancelled several shows this weekend because of an outbreak in their office which is on their showground at Durack.

We will continue to keep the situation monitored. Council's meeting last week was held electronically to minimise the possibility of transmission and we are keeping a careful watch on the AGM on 14 March 2022 to see if it would be better to postpone it for the safety of members. The Constitution requires that it be held by 30 June 2022.

May I again implore members to take precautions at all times especially at shows and trials. Masks are mandatory at all times indoors. It also makes sense to wear them as much as possible. We are still concerned about exhibitors congregating in the assembly areas. You should not be there unless your breed is actually being judged.

The launch of Dogs Australia is proceeding smoothly with a lot of good exposure in the mainstream media over the past month or two. This will be ramped up in the coming months.

Speaking of ramps, it is expected that ANKC will approve new regulations for ramps and a number of clubs have indicated they will donate a ramp so ramps should soon be in use in Tasmania.

In the past week another meeting has been held with Brighton Council regarding the shed. Without going into all the 'details' we hope a pathway has now been agreed upon to ensure it will be available for use as soon as possible.

I will again remind members of the problems with puppy scammers 'stealing' membership numbers to include in advertisements for puppies. The office continues to receive calls from people who have parted with their money and there is no puppy. Part of the Dogs Australia project is to make potential puppy buyers aware of the 'dos and don'ts' of puppy buying.

The move of the office to Chapel Street has gone smoothly with the bugs now ironed out. The library books are now properly housed and clubs have started to use the meeting room for their meetings. Thank you to everyone who has assisted.

Everyone stay healthy so that we can continue to enjoy our many activities.

Dogs Tasmania Constitution

- 20.4** The quorum for all committees' and Sub- Committees' meetings shall be 50% of the members of such committees or sub-committees plus one, providing at all times the minimum number of members at a committee or sub-committee meeting is not less than 3 (three) members.

be amended by the addition of the words **with six (6) or more members** between the words *meetings and shall be...* and the addition of the words **For those committees or sub-committees with six (6) members or less it shall be 50%** after the words *plus one*. 20.4 to then read:

- 20.4** The quorum for all committees' and Sub-committees' meetings **with six (6) or more members** shall be 50% of the members of such committees or sub-committees plus one. **For those committees or sub-committees with six (6) members or less it shall be 50%**, providing at all times the minimum number of members at a committee or sub committee meeting is not less than three (3) members.

Rationale

The current procedure is to round **up** to the next whole member but in cases where the number of members of a committee or sub-committee is small this is somewhat unrealistic. An example is the Stewards Committee which consists of five members. According to 20.4 of the constitution a quorum is 2.5 (50%) plus one making a total of 3.5. This is then rounded up to make four. This means that if two members are unable to attend there is not a quorum. Consideration should also be given to rewording the opening line to read *The quorum for all meetings of committees and sub-committees...*

* * * * *

- 21.2** Complaints (except complaints against employees) received by the TCA shall be assessed by not less than two (2) members of the Investigation Panel.

be amended by the words **"not less than two (2) members"** being replaced by the words **"not less than three (3) members"**.

Rationale

In the new constitution that was adopted 21/9/2021 "a member" was increased to **"not less than two (2) members"**. Whilst this was a step in the right direction toward a more fair and judicial system, I do not consider two enough. With just two members there is a risk of a stalemate and, as such, it is much better to have an odd number of members making such decisions.

* * * * *

General Business

Reg 96 requires complaints to be lodged within seven days and for the Executive Officer to advise the person against whom the complaint has been made within 14 days but there does not appear to be a time frame for how soon any action must be taken. Is there a reason for this?

Rationale

A member or affiliate can receive notification that a complaint has been lodged against him/her/ them and then left wondering what is happening for several weeks. For some this could be quite stressful. Should it not be in the vicinity of 28 or 30 days or one calendar month from the date of issue of such advice? I am aware of a case where those involved were left wondering for more than 10 weeks. Is this length of time really necessary?

8 ELIGIBILITY TO NOMINATE FOR ELECTION

- 8.1 No person shall be eligible for election or appointment, or be elected or appointed pursuant to this Clause, unless the person at the time of closing of nominations:
- 8.1.1 Is a financial member of the TCA and at least eighteen (18) years of age.
 - 8.1.2 Has been a financial member of the TCA, or an ANKC affiliated body, for a continuous period of at least five (5) years up to and including the closing date for nominations.
 - This clause is unnecessarily onerous in nature and is prejudicial to members who would be reasonably/more qualified to perform the role of Councillor as that of a member of five (5) years. Suggest that this be requirement is reduced to being a current financial member of at least 12 months.
 - 8.1.3 Has served as a member of the Council, or of an ANKC affiliated body, or has held an executive position on a body affiliated with the TCA or with a body affiliated with a member body of the ANKC for a period or periods in total of not less than two (2) years or has held an executive position on the committee of a body, Incorporated under the Act, for a period or periods in total of not less than two (2) years, in addition to having held an executive position on a body affiliated with the TCA or with a body affiliated with a member body of the ANKC for a period or periods in total of not less than one (1) year.
 - This clause is unnecessarily onerous in nature and is prejudicial to members who would be reasonably/more qualified either through experience with member bodies or committees or through their professional/vocational experience. Membership of a qualifying body in and itself does not ensure a person is inherently qualified to perform the role of a Councillor nor they bring the necessary skills/professional qualifications to the position. Further, given the limited opportunities available to obtain these roles it further diminishes the pool of nominees to the detriment of the members and the Council. Suggest that this clause is changed to include appropriately qualified professionals who can demonstrate their capabilities and abilities to the benefit of the organisation.
 - It is worth noting these qualifying criteria are more stringent than a publicly listed company and are not subject to the same corporate governance controls.
 - This also restrict the influx of new ideas and is poor corporate governance.
 - 8.1.4 Executive positions of affiliates are those of President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary.
 - See previous point
 - 8.1.5 Subject to Clause 12.3, the term of an elected Councillor shall be three (3) years, commencing on 1 February in the year of election and terminating three years later on 31 January.
- 8.2 No person shall be eligible for election or appointment, or be elected or appointed for more than two (2) consecutive terms
- A person shall be eligible for election or appointment, or be elected or appointed for after serving two (2) consecutive terms provided a period of not less than three (3) years has elapsed since the cessation of their second consecutive term.
 - Councillors should be required to rotate to ensure good corporate governance within the organisation. This can be assured by restricting Councillors from being elected indefinitely and under a prejudicial qualifying criterion, which could see persons elected to the Council despite there being better or more qualified candidates.

12 OFFICE OF COUNCILLOR BECOMING VACANT

- 12.2 The appointment of a person to take the office of Councillor the office of whom has become vacant or the term of office of whom has expired, shall be made as soon as possible after the office has become vacant or the term has expired, as the case may be, subject to Clause 12.6.
- This clause refers to Clause 12.6, however there is no such clause.

12.4 If the office of a person elected as a Councillor becomes vacant other than as a result of the effluxion of the term for which they were elected, the Council may appoint a person to the office of that Councillor for the unexpired part of the term of that Councillor. Upon such appointment being made, the person so appointed shall be deemed to be an elected Councillor within the meaning and for the purpose of Clause 6.

- This clause gives the Council absolute discretion to appoint whoever they deem fit for the remainder of a term. This eventuality should result in nominations being called for from the membership and in the event of multiple applicants a by-election held to determine the successor.
- This clause in its current form would be a classic example of bad corporate governance and goes against the spirit of nominating members to the Council with diverse views and opinions not to mention the fact every Councillor should be appointed by the membership not the Council directly.

14 THE PRESIDENT

14.3 The President may not serve more than six (6) consecutive terms

- The President should not be able to serve more than two (2) consecutive terms in one election period or no more than four (4) terms over two consecutive election periods provided they do not run concurrently. This is good corporate governance and should be considered best practice in any organisation.

We are internationally recognised breeders of the world famous Landmaster Australian Cattle Dogs, with over 100 Champions in Australia and overseas.

Aust Ch and International Ch Landmaster UShow Them How holds 13 titles in many different countries and is believed to be the only Australian Cattle Dog to hold this many titles. Aust Ch Landmaster USundowner (Sunny), a Red Speckle, put the Australian Cattle Dog to the forefront in the Australian show ring, winning 18 Best in Shows (All Breeds), plus many Specialty Best in Shows. He was also the first Australian Cattle Dog to win Best in Group at an Australian Royal Show winning Best in Group and Opposite sex In Show at Melbourne Royal 1978, from a large entry of 7,397 dogs.

We have been extremely lucky with our Australian Cattle Dogs, winning many Groups and In Show awards at Royal shows. Our beautiful American Aust Supreme Champion Landmaster Memphis Blues (Memphis) winning Best In Group then going on to win Runner Up In Show at Darwin Royal from the Junior Class. His show career was outstanding, winning many Best In Shows all over Australia, then going to the USA in 2013 to be shown at the Australian Cattle Dog National. IF YOUR ANSWER IS YES TO ANY OF THE ABOVE PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE GROUNDS.

INTERSTATE EXHIBITORS MUST BE DOUBLE VACCINATED.

Masks must be worn indoors (including canteen and office staff) and, if the 1.5 metre social distancing requirement cannot be adhered to, all attendees are encouraged to wear masks outside.

Before judging

- Upon arrival ALL exhibitors and any additional people/guests must check in using the Tas Government QR code. CLUBS are required to ensure that the QR Code for the venue is available around the grounds and ensure there are multiple copies at the table for exhibit number collection. A pen and paper (this must be sanitised after use) must also be available with name and phone number information collected for anyone not able to use the Tasmanian Gov QR code App.;
- The club is to ensure sanitiser is available for use on the office desk;
- The club is to ensure 1.5m is observed by anyone waiting to check in, and
- TCA Reps report paperwork is to include a copy of the current guidelines to ensure adherence to the safety protocol is followed.

Judging

- All Judges are to be given advice of the guidelines BEFORE judging;
- The Judge should not shake hands with any exhibitor – use the elbow bump instead;
- Stewards are to ensure assembly areas are kept clear with only the next few breeds in the immediate area,
- If competitors in a performance sport are required to remove their leads, they should carry them themselves, and
- Sanitiser must be readily available for Judges and Stewards.

General

- All areas to be controlled and the current social distancing requirement enforced. Event Managers/Club Officials can suspend activity and request people to leave the grounds or stop the fixture completely if people do not adhere to social distancing rules;
- Committee to ensure there is appropriate soap and paper towel in the toilets throughout the day;
- Any canteen facilities must observe safe food and cash handling (we recommend having one designated person responsible for the cash handling only);
- Hand sanitiser must be available for canteen patrons to use, and
- Canteen workers must ensure distancing is observed both inside the canteen and also by the customers and wear masks at all times whilst in the canteen.

Attending the Event

No one is to attend the event if they have COVID-19 symptoms, stay at home if you are unwell or have a cough, fever, sore throat, fatigue or shortness of breath. SHOW AND TRIAL REGULATIONS

All exhibitions conducted by the Tasmanian Canine Association Inc and its affiliates are conducted under the rules and regulations of the Association, a copy of which may be inspected at the office of the event manager of the exhibition on the day of such exhibition.

The following rules/regulations apply to all exhibitions:

Financial Members:

A person 18 years of age and over and who is a resident of Tasmania may not exhibit, handle, officiate in the judging ring or register an animal unless he/she is a current financial member of the TCA Inc. A person seven years and under the age of eighteen years who handles a dog in the judging ring is required to be a junior member of the TCA Inc or a member of an affiliated club. At least one parent or guardian is required to be a financial member of the TCA Inc.

Entry fees must accompany the entry form and should be paid by cheque or money order (refer Australia Post regulation).

Substitute Judges:

The affiliate conducting an exhibition reserves the right to substitute judges if the committee deems it necessary. Entry fees are not refundable – refer TCA Inc Regulation 227.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have his/her exhibit/s available for judging in all classes or events for which it is correctly entered and for the classes for which it subsequently becomes eligible – TCA Inc Regulation 33 + 33A.
